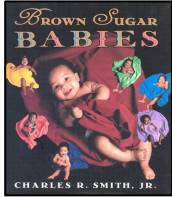
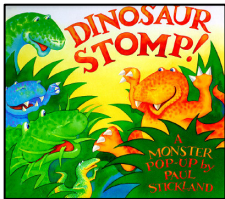

Smith, Charles R. Jr./ **Brown Sugar Babies**

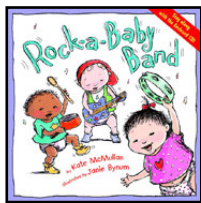
Illustrations and rhyming text describe babies in terms of different sweet and tasty brown treats. **Ju E Smi**



Stickland, Paul A/ **Dinosaur Stomp!**

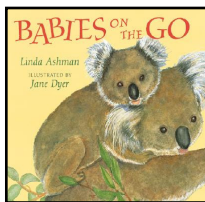
A colorful collection of dinosaurs heads off for a "stomp in the swamp."

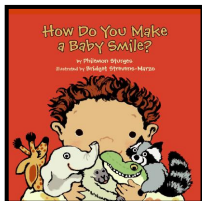
McMullan, Kate/ **Rock-a-Baby Band**

Ten babies sing, dance, and use a variety of instruments to make music together. **Ju E McM**



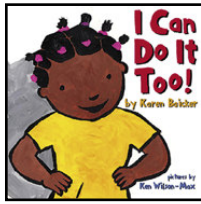
Ashman, Linda/ **Babies on the Go**

Illustrations and rhyming text show how different animals carry their babies when they are on the move. **Ju E Ash**



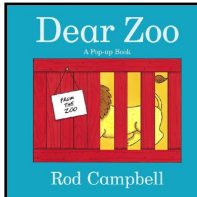
Sturges, Philemon/ **How do you make a baby smile?**

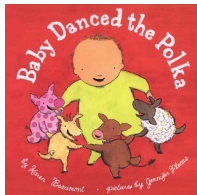
Baicker, Karen / **I Can Do it Too**

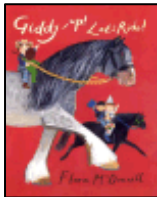
Campbell, Rod **Dear Zoo**
