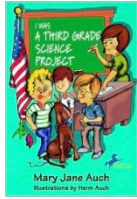

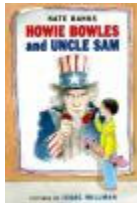


### **I Was a Third Grade Science Project**

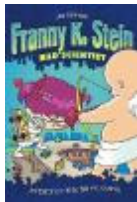


### **Howie Bowles and Uncle Sam**

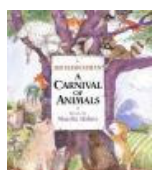

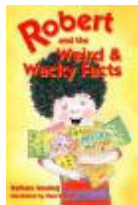
